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Officers are elected for a term of one (1) year or until their successors are elected.
Directors are elected for a term of two years with the even numbered director positions expiring during the even numbered years and the odd numbered director positions expiring during the odd numbered years.

PRESIDENT: Chief Executive Officer, The President shall execute all contracts, and other documents. Expenditures or transactions exceeding a value of \$300 must be approved by a majority of the GC and countersigned by the Financial Officer.

FIRST VICE PRESIDENT. The 1st Vice-President shall serve as the chairman of the Operations Committee and will assist the President.

SECOND VICE PRESIDENT. Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee and also be responsible for public affairs and community relations.

FINANCIAL OFFICER. The Financial Officer will be the chairman of the Finance Committee, keep a record of all moneys received and paid out and shall make a report of the same at each meeting or upon request. The Financial Officer shall co-sign, with the President or 1st Vice-President, all financial instruments, and documents.

SECRETARY. The Secretary shall attend all meetings, record all minutes and votes of all proceedings in a book to be kept for that purpose, and shall perform duties for standing committees when required. The Secretary shall give, or cause to be given, notice of called meetings to all GC members in advance.

(a) *PRESIDENT. The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the GC. He shall preside over all meetings of the GC and shall see that all orders and resolutions of the GC are affected. The President shall execute all bonds, mortgages, contracts, and other documents. Expenditures or transactions exceeding a value of \$300 must be approved by a majority of the GC and countersigned by the Financial Officer.*

(b) *FIRST VICE PRESIDENT. The 1st Vice-President shall serve as the chairman of the Operations Committee and will assist the President. This officer will also serve as the President in the absence of the President.*

(c) *SECOND VICE PRESIDENT. The 2nd Vice-President shall serve as the chairman of the Ways and Means Committee and also be responsible for public affairs and community relations. He/She shall act on behalf of the President or 1st Vice-President in their absence.*

(e) *FINANCIAL OFFICER. The Financial Officer will be the chairman of the Finance Committee, keep a record of all moneys received and paid out by the GC, and shall make a report of the same at each monthly meeting or upon request of the GC. The Financial Officer shall co-sign, with the President or 1st Vice-President, all financial instruments, and documents.*

(f) *SECRETARY. The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the GC, record all minutes and votes of all proceedings in a book to be kept for that purpose, and shall perform duties for standing committees when required. The Secretary shall give, or cause to be given, notice of called meetings to all GC members in advance.*

(g) *Offices of (e) FINANCIAL OFFICER and (f) SECRETARY may be held by the same person.*
